



Code Name Edelweiss By Stephanie Landsem


Adolf Hitler is still a distant rumble on the horizon, but a Jewish spymaster and his courageous spies uncover a storm of Nazi terror in their own backyard.

The Guncle By Steven Rowley


A warm and deeply funny novel about a once-famous sitcom star whose unexpected family tragedy leaves him with his niece and nephew.

Heaven and Earth Grocery Store By James McBride



A Fever in the Heartland By Timothy Egan



Remarkably Bright Creatures By Shelby Van Pelt


A book revolving around a mischievous giant pacific octopus in a small town aquarium, attended by a lovely old lady who cleans it.
